Monday – December 21, 2009

Lots of activity today with most of the trades present. The electrical work continues to be completed in the new mechanical room. The HVAC duct work is continuing in the new office areas and Fellowship Hall. The plumber completed the work on the restroom in Pre-school and the demolition group removed most of their support beams and prepared Fellowship Hall for the final downstairs wall removal. The masons were also working today. They finished the entrances to the utility room and cleaned up the walls for electrical conduit runs.



The first steel beam in Fellowship Hall is now in place. The second wall will be removed on Tuesday

Tuesday – December 22, 2009

Today the final wall in Fellowship Hall was removed. Hopefully this will be the end of the dirty dirt for awhile. The supports will be in the corner until after Christmas then the steel beam will be placed and the room prepared for drywall. The electrician has been running conduit to all the pole surrounds and the majority of the duct work is now completed in Fellowship Hall. The next push will be to create the new duct vents into the sanctuary. The offices are now ready for inspection prior to adding the drywall and insulation. The masons still need to place the new window the pastor's office. The first good weather day after Christmas should see that activity.
